Our Week ABC boot camp this week focused on the letters K, V, W and Y. As we near the end of bootcamp, the letters and sounds get a bit harder. Check in with your child to see if they are making these letter correctly, and if they can tell you the sounds they make! During Daily 5, we continued to work on building stamina for writing and buddy reading. Buddy reading has been a little difficult, because students are so used to reading books by themselves. They have had to learn strategies of how to read with a partner. They learned that they can read one book together, or they can each pick a book and take turns reading them to each other. It's also hard for them to focus on reading, when they want to talk about other things instead. They have done a great ish they and area dready up to 5 minutes job though, and are already up to 5 minutes. We finished our shapes book this week and talked about hexagons. The class did a very good job thinking of things that are in the shape of a hexăgon! We also began talking more about positional language (above, below, beside, between, etc.) In science, students talked about clouds. We wrote down all of the things they know about clouds, as well as things they want to know about clouds. After we read a book about

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them, we wrote what they learned.

Next week we will continue building stamina for Daily 5. We did not get to our new station, word work this week, so students will begin learning about that on Wednesday. They also will be trying to get their staminia for writing to 15 minutes on Tuesday, which is the goal. Fingers crossed!



In science, we will continue our work with clouds. The students will learn about 4 different types of clouds, and make them out of different materials. We will also do a cloud in a cup experiment.
