Our Week

ABC boot camp this week focused on the letters P, J, L and H. The class has improved so much on remembering letter sounds, which is helping them tremendously as they attempt to sound out and write words. Ask your child to show you their favorite letter movement dance! During Daily 5, we worked on building stamina for 3 stations this week. The students hit their stamina goal of 15 minutes for read to self on Tuesday! I am so proud of them for accomplishing this. We are working on building stamina for writing and buddy reading to 15-20 minutes as well. During work on writing, they have been learning how to use picture cards to help them label, make a list, write a story, write a letter or write a card. For buddy reading, they learned how to sit EEKK (elbow, elbow, knee, knee) with a partner, how to use a soft voice, and to take turns reading the pages to each other.

We did apple science this week, and did many activities to learn more about apples. They learned how apples get from an orchard to the grocery store, what the different parts of an apple are called, if an apple sinks or floats in water and we created a graph of their favorite kind of apple today. I even juggled 3 apples for them to celebrate the end of our apple week!
