Our Week

We continued ABC bootcamp this week, and learned about the letters N, M, I and U. Ask your child to do one of their letter dances for you!
Along with all of our morning activities that the students do for bootcamp, they have also been doing handwriting bootcamp. They are learning how to make capital and lowercase letters, always starting from the top. They did a great job once again during show and tell, telling the class what their item was, what letter it started with, and the sound that letter makes.

For math this week, the students learned about the number 1, and also did the first page of their shapes book, which was all about circles.

We did a lot of activities pertaining to Chicka Chicka Boom Boom this week as well. We read the book, watched the animated version, did our Chicka Chicka Boom Boom poem, and ended the week with a project where they made their own coconut tree with letters climbing up it!

Next week we will begin taking the MAP test. The students take these tests on the computer. We will start next week with our reading MAP tests on Wednesday and Friday. We will also continue learning about Daily 5. The students will continue to build stamina for read to self and work on writing. They will learn what it means to pick a 'good fit' book for them.

We will begin our Author Study on Mo Willems next week. The students will learn about speech bubbles and how our voices change levels when we read small words compared to all capital words.

In math, we will continue to practice shapes and numbers. Students will do their square page in their shapes book, and try to come up with 4 things in the world that are shaped like a square.
